What We Believe: The Lord's Supper

## **MORNING SERVICE**

"The Lord's Supper is a symbolic act of obedience whereby members of the church, through partaking of the bread and the fruit of the vine, memorialize the death of the Redeemer and anticipate His second coming." (BF&M, Article VII)

Scripture: I Corinthians 11:23-29

I believe that Jesus being fully God and fully man died on the cross, taking my place, so I consume the bread of the Lord's Supper in remembrance of His death for me.
